## WE WILL REMEMBER THEM

Last Friday we took time to discuss and reflect on the service and sacrifice of current and former military personnel as part of our Remembrance Day activities. We held a special assembly and the whole school observed a minutes silence.

Our school council did a fantastic job visiting each classroom selling poppies and other items. We will share the total amount raised soon.

Jake brought in his great-great-grandfather's World War One medals to show us. He proudly told his class about his career as an engineer and how he arranged concerts to entertain the soldiers in France.



Year 6 stepped back in time as a World War 2 evacuees. The children dressed up and walked to St Austell train station. This helped the children to understand what children their age would have felt as they left their homes in the city to be evacuated to St. Austell on the train. The children then took part in an 'Evacuate or Hesitate' workshop finding themselves in the position of parents, evacuees, and those taking in evacuees. They were given role-play scenarios which gave the children a greater understanding of why evacuations took place, where evacuees were sent, the difficult position parents found themselves in when deciding to send their children away, and the mixed experiences reported by real evacuees about their time away from home. The whole experience brought history to life!





# EYFS

EYFS enjoyed engaging in their new ILP 'Why Do Squirrels Hide Their Nuts?' on an autumn walk around the school. The children used a checklist to mark down what they could see and hear. The children enjoyed a yummy hot chocolate in our forest area after retelling the story 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt!'

This week, in science, Year 1 have been exploring the human body and the five senses. The children began with a blind taste test, followed by the children then recording their findings in a table.

It was discovered that we use both smell and taste when tasting food! Super work Year 1.

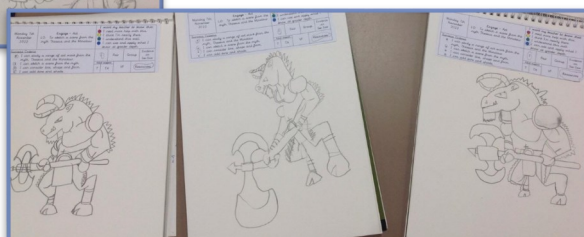
# YEAR 2

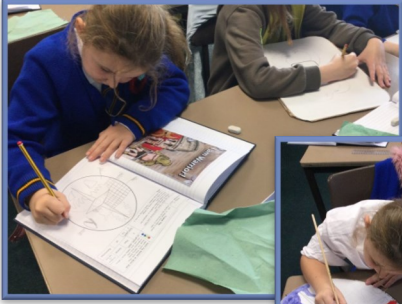

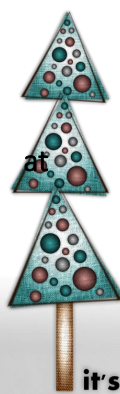
