- keep parents informed about school activities through regular newsletters;
- inform parents what children will be learning throughout the course of the year;
- arrange parents' meetings during which progress will be discussed;
- set and monitor homework for children.

We seek your agreement to:

- make sure that your child arrives on time our school gates open at 8:25am. Registration starts at 8:30am.
- make sure that your child attends regularly, providing a note of explanation for absence and not taking holidays in term time.
- attend parent consultations to discuss your child's progress;
- support your child in learning to read and in completing homework;
- support the school's policy on behaviour;
- ensure your child is well rested, eats well and is ready to learn;
- talk positively about the school within our community and contact the school if you have a concern.

- keep each other informed of concerns we may have about children's learning;
- tackle any special needs which may arise;
- encourage children to join lunchtime and after school clubs;
- support children's learning to help them achieve their best.
