This week, Year 5 and 6 were given the amazing opportunity to meet the celebrated author Maz Evans. Her books include, Who Let the Gods Out, VI Spy and the Scarlett Fife series. They have collectively sold over half a million copies to 22 countries worldwide, and have received over 30 award nominations, including Waterstones Children's Book of the Year!

During the session the children learnt about her writing and she read a chapter from her new book which was very funny and inspiring! The children asked some great questions and we hope they feel inspired to write their own books or read some books written by Maz. Maz was hilarious and had our children and staff holding their sides with laughter! Definitely lots of new Maz Evans fans in the club and more children excited to read.

EYFS have been reading, 'On Sudden Hill' by Linda Sarah & Benji Davies. They read the story together and then talked about what happened in the story and all of the amazing things the boxes became. This inspired the children to create their own cardboard box creations.









Year 1 have been designing dinosaur puppets. First they needed to understand the purpose of a puppet and had fun exploring different puppets with their peers to help them write a design criteria. The children then used this to design four different dinosaur puppets. Mr Hughes and Miss McNally were very impressed with the focus and attention to detail the children put into their designs!





Year 2 have been practicing their sculpting skills in art this week, ready to create their sea creature sculptures next week. They practiced pinching, hand building, rolling and etching techniques to change the shape of the clay and to add texture and pattern.











In PE, Year 3 have been following a Gymnastics unit called Stretching, Arching and Curling. This week we were looking at taking weight on our hands as well as creating a sequence with our partner.









This week Year 4 have been inspired by the artist Georges Seurat; creating colour harmony and perfecting their pointillism techniques.



The children have been working hard to follow instructions, for example, using recipes. They enjoyed making and decorating cupcakes and even did the washing up after!







This week, nine children from Years 5 and 6 took part in the Cross Fit Festival at Poltair School The children learnt what cross fit is and some of the activities included in a cross fit session. They all showed excellent determination and worked on building stamina.


**Lucky Draw Week:** We also have a lucky draw week each half-term. In this week, any pupil who has achieved 100% for the week will receive a treat and be put into a prize draw! There will be a KS1 and a KS2 prize. Next week is our next lucky draw week!

**Big end of term reward:** Every term we will have an attendance reward for all pupils who have achieved 96.8% or higher during that term. At the end of this autumn term, the children will be treated to a hot chocolate and Christmas film. At the start of each term (for the purpose of the reward only) we start every child's attendance at 100%. This means that every child has a chance to achieve 96.8% each term and enjoy the celebration.

**Absence from school:** If your child is unable to attend school, please contact the school office via telephone before 9am. Please give full details of the reason for absence so that our admin team can code the absence appropriately. Please avoid using phrases such as "poorly" or "sick" and instead give details of symptoms. Repeat this for every day of absence. If you know you may need to request leave from school for **exceptional circumstances**, such as national sports competitions or visa appointments, please complete a leave request form from the office.

**Yearly attendance** will continue to be monitored weekly and we will send out attendance information via Class Dojo at the start of each term for any pupils with attendance below 93%. Each week, class teachers will be made aware of pupil's attendance for the year to date and may contact you to discuss your child's attendance.
