The children have loved building new relationships and exploring the different areas of their learning environments with new friends! They particularly enjoy using their imagination to construct models using the building blocks!







Holbein, combining the skills they have learned over the past few weeks to create a detailed portrait using shading and colour mixing.









Year 6 have continued with their art project this half term. They have enjoyed looking at how they can take realistic images and turn them into an abstract piece. They used a mixture of water colours and pen to create their final pieces which we are looking forward to displaying next half term.







The children in the ARB have enjoyed learning all about their senses exploring the sense of touch by scooping out a pumpkin and making lovely artwork with scented paint.

We would like to celebrate the achievements of George, Year 5. George has achieved an amazing result at the British Youth Trials championship!
