



Mount Charles School Home Reading Offer









Every child receives a Mount Charles bookbag on their arrival to school.

Children are expected to read with an adult **at least 3 times per week** at home. Boom Reader online reading journals will be used to record reading at home and in school and will be carefully tracked by teachers and Reading Leaders to identify target children for additional reading support.

Children who are learning to read within the Read, Write Inc. program are expected to read the same book at least three times to allow **accuracy, fluency and comprehension** skills to be developed.

Children in our **Nursery Class** will have access to a wide range of high-quality fiction and non-fiction books to share at home as part of our **Nursery Book Borrowing Library**.

Children who have been assessed as working above Grey level will have progressed off of the RWI program. Children will complete a Star Reader assessment within the Accelerated Reader scheme. This assessment will generate a ZPD level which will support children to choose reading materials which are appropriate to their reading level.

Children will have the opportunity to also take home a range of carefully selected Reading Spine texts as part of the schools reading for pleasure initiative.
