drum kit hi-hat has a 'tight' cymbal sound

head = the term used in jazz/ groove music to describe the main melody of a song

snare drum has a midrange, 'sharp' sound

Genre = Jazz

Backbeat = usually falls on beats 2 and 4 and often played by the snare drum electric bass guitar





