The children in EYFS have been discussing how we are all different in many ways, the word they have learnt for this is 'unique'. They have been looking closely at themselves in a mirror and have painted their








very own self portraits. The children have enjoyed capturing their special features and carefully painting these.

In geography, Year 1 have been learning about the world's continents. The children used atlases to locate where each continent is in the world and then played some fun games to test their knowledge about what they learnt.









Year 2 have been practicing their sketching skills in art and design this week. The children have been learning to use different shapes, lines and textures to create a sketch of a sea creature.





Year 3 enjoyed a visit from Mark's Ark. The children learnt about





tarantulas, snakes, a vulture and a lizard. All the animals that came to visit were predators linked to their 'predator' topic this term. The children were extremely brave when given the opportunity to hold them!



Year 4 had an incredible day exploring the National Marine Aquarium in Plymouth: they became marine biologists and submerged themselves to the depths of the ocean using virtual reality; they looked inside the stomach of a whale and found food and plastic which led them to discuss ways to protect our oceans' and finally, they got up close with all the aquatic life including 10 sharks!









On Tuesday, the whole of Year 5 took part in a CELT sports event at Poltair School, alongside other schools from within our Trust. The children took part in a range of activities including golf, target throw and practising a variety of ball skills. The event provided them with the opportunity to develop a range of physical and social skills whilst, most importantly, having fun!





Year 6 have been practising making different tints, tones and shades of colour as they study the work of Kandinsky. This skill will be useful to them when they produce their final piece.











The children have been enjoying reading their class story Biscuit Bear and made and decorated biscuits. In maths, they have been adding by counting on, using marks and pictures to represent numbers, doing puzzles and counting.





Mr Yelland took a group of Year 6 children to Poltair School to participate in a rounders festival. The children enjoyed the friendly competition, and were excellent representatives for our school .

ATTENDANCE

We strive for 100% attendance for all pupils. Attending school regularly is important both academically and socially. When pupils are absent from school they miss vital learning and building relationships with their friends.

At Mount Charles we celebrate good attendance.

How we celebrate good attendance

Each week, the class with the highest attendance is awarded the attendance trophy and an extra break time. Congratulations to 3SG, 5RW, 1NM, 2HM and 2SC who have already been awarded the trophy this term.

Lucky Draw Week

We also have a lucky draw week each half-term which we will announce on the Friday before. In this week, any pupil who has achieved 100% for the week will be put into a prize draw. There will be a KS1 and a KS2 prize.

Attendance Reward

Every term we will have an attendance reward for all pupils who have achieved 96.8% or higher for the term.

At the start of each term (Autumn, Spring and Summer) **for the purpose of the reward only** we start every child's attendance at 100%. This means that every child has a chance to achieve 96.8% each term and enjoy the celebration.

<u>Yearly attendance</u> will continue to be monitored weekly and we will send out attendance information via Class Dojo at the start of each term for any pupils with attendance below 93%. Each week, class teachers will be made aware of pupil's attendance for the year to date and may contact you to discuss your child's attendance.

Well done and thank you to those pupils whose attendance is already improving from last term, this is fantastic.

Reminder of what to do if your child is absent:

· Contact the school office via telephone on the first day of their child's absence **before 9am**.

• Provide us with the full details of the reason for their absence. Please <u>avoid</u> using phrases such as "poorly" or "sick".

Repeat this for every day of absence.


